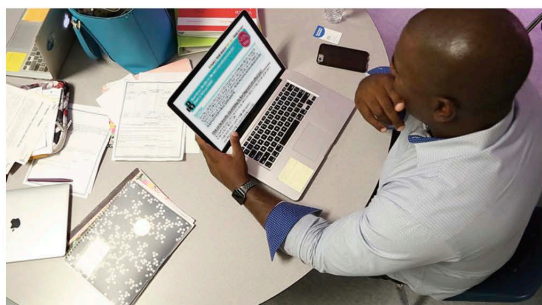
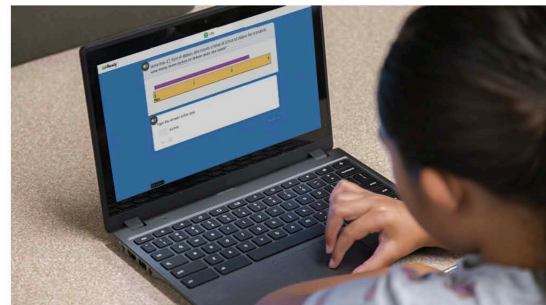




Assessing at Home Support
