WHAT is the A+ Scholarship program?

- Provides 2 years of tuition at a community college, vocational school, or technical school.
- Impressive looking achievement on college and scholarship applications.
- Helps students focus on grades and attendance.
- Students serve the community as a tutor and/or mentor.
- Some 4 year schools give scholarships based on whether you have A+ or not.

Important news on COVID (SY20-21)

- Seniors completing 25 hours of unpaid tutoring or mentoring will be considered to have met this requirement. (As of January 26, 2022, students may be required to complete the original 50 hours.)
- 12.5 hours can be completed through an approved job shadow
- 95% attendance record can be appealed for grades 9-12
- The cumulative, unrounded, and unweighted 2.5 GPA is still in effect.
- The Algebra I EOC/ACT Math requirement is still in effect, so you will need to have scored Proficient or Advanced on the Algebra I EOC or score a 17 on the Math section of the ACT.

Terms to Know

- Community College Local school to complete your first TWO years of college; Readies students for FOUR years of college
- Vocational School (Career Tech)- school where you learn special skills (Culinary arts, Cosmetology, Automotive careers, Construction careers, and more!
 Example: <u>Herndon Career Center in Raytown</u>

WHO is A+ designed for?

- US citizen, permanent resident, or lawfully present in the United States.
- Enter into a written agreement with your high school prior before graduation.
- Attend a designated A+ high school for 3 consecutive years.
- Helps a variety of Pell eligible students and "middle class" families

WHERE can I use A+ Scholarship Money?

- There's no limit to how much A+ scholarship money can be used by an applicant. The program pays for \$189 dollars

- Four Year Colleges with A+ SCHOLARSHIPS for KCPS Students

WHAT are the requirements of the Program?

- 2.5 cumulative GPA
- 95% Attendance
- 25 hours of tutoring and or mentoring (50 hours)
- 12.5 hours of job shadowing (25%)
- Math Requirement on EOC or ACT
- Attend A+ school for 3 of 4 years
- Good citizenship
