




Distribution of Progress to Annual




Distribution of Progress to Annual

Typical Growth



Distribution of Progress to Annual Stretch Growth




#### **Current Placement Distribution**






#### **Overall Placement**






#### Placement By Domain





## **KCPS Recruitment Strategies**

- > Traditional College Visits Recruitment
  - ➤ 37 University visits scheduled for SY20
    - HBCUs based on district staff alumni affiliation
    - Texas State University/ Puerto Rico
- ➤ Teacher Recruitment Team (Began in January 2019)
  - ≥ 15 KCPS Teachers
  - Required to attend at least 2 recruitment events per year
  - Each member tasked with:
    - Promoting district with a positive image
    - Assist with identifying quality teacher candidates
    - Assist with interviewing candidates for future positions






